Short description:

Namibia is a signatory to the SDGs, which were adopted in September 2015, and as a country has committed to fulfilling the targets of the SDGs within its borders and assisting the global community as a whole. The Games for the SDGs are coordinated by Progress Namibia, in partnership with the National Youth Council (NYC), the Youth Coalition on Climate Change, AISEC Namibia and the Hanns-Seidel Foundation. The Games make use of simulations and other interactive tools to create a relatable platform for Namibians, specifically the youth, to engage with the intricacies of the SDGs within the Namibian context. They aim to provide higher education, undertake research, advance and disseminate knowledge, to provide extension services, to encourage the growth and nurturing of cultural expressions within the context of the Namibian society, to further training and continuing education, contribute to social and economic development of Namibia, and to foster relationships with any person or institution both nationally and internationally – University of Namibia Act of 1992 (Act 18 of 1992).
