Short description:

Play Flag Football is a national-scale project, whose goal is to motivate kids to be active. It has connected the school environment with sports experts to create a platform providing teachers with useful know-how and support to help them to prepare quality PE classes.

Another project, Eco-friendly Sports, promotes sport and physical activities that not only contribute to better health, but also have a positive impact on the environment, developing new methods of environmental education through sport and increasing the number of locally organised initiatives like clean-up events, plogging, planting trees, birdhouse building and repair cafés. Sport Education Against Radicalisation is a project aiming to prevent the radicalisation of young people by encouraging social inclusion and equal opportunities in sport. It has created a network of 8 ambassadors who will reach out to young people at local events using the Education Through Sport (ETS) methodology and will implement a series of online awareness-raising actions and sport events.

RISE - Roma Inclusion through Sport in Europe is tackling discrimination, social exclusion and marginalisation of Roma youngsters through an exchange of good practices, capacity building activities and the development and implementation of sport-based educational activities.
