Promoting children's rights and gender equality through sport

Short description:

Plan International aims to harness children's love of sport. It runs football projects in Benin, Nicaragua and Brazil, where Plan International is actively striving to advance children's rights and gender equality through sport.

The Team La League project aims to let as many girls as possible play football, because football makes girls strong! Not only in the Netherlands, but also in Latin America, where football helps to combat inequality between girls and boys. Anyone who participates in Team La League and has collected at least 50 euros can participate in the Finals. Each club in the Eredivisie for women has its own Finals in June this year. During this day of the finals, girls – and this year for the first time also boys – can play football with the players from the Eredivisie, follow clinics and show their football skills!
