Social inclusion of children with special needs

**Short description:**

The LEBANON - STAIRS project aims to promote access to educational services and the social inclusion of vulnerable Syrian and Lebanese children with special needs, guaranteeing adequate accessible and inclusive educational facilities and protected environments created through recreational actions that involve communities. The project is being carried out in collaboration with the Lebanese municipalities of Tall Bire and Bebnine, Province of Akkar, the municipality of Nabi Osmane, and Province of Baalbek-Hermel. The proposed action therefore aims to achieve the protection of minors by implementing and promoting actions of social inclusion and knowledge of the other. It takes into consideration gender differences and previous vulnerabilities identified or reported by the school staff during the assessment carried out in the preliminary phase, and aims to promote the inclusion of children with physical-motor and/or mental disabilities, as well as refugee girls and children present in the territory, also allowing to identify those cases that have not been previously identified by the school staff and to ensure a listening space where necessary.
