Short description:

“Sport for Development” or S4D (Indonesian title: Olahraga untuk Pembangunan) in Indonesia was a programme running from May 2018 to December 2021. The overall objective of the programme was to establish different sports – such as football, volleyball, gymnastics and traditional games – as tools and vehicles for value education, promotion of life skills and healthy lifestyles in Indonesian educational and sporting structures. The S4D programme focused especially on promoting the development of children and youth by encompassing the qualitative and quantitative improvement of educational physical activities and sport-for-all programmes to foster physical literacy, promote a healthy lifestyle and anti-violence.
